This journal supports scientists in publishing their protocol as an early scientific record when reporting on developments of novel methodologies, software, or innovations.

By publishing your protocol in *JMIR Research Protocols*, you also encourage collaboration, reduce duplication of scientific effort, and demonstrate to future reviewers that your subsequent results paper adheres to carefully developed a priori methods. This demonstrates a commitment to transparency and scientific rigor, helping to make research more reproducible and combat publication bias. Publishing a *JMIR Research Protocols* paper also offers authors a seamless path for subsequent publication of their results (also known as Registered Report Stage 2 papers) in a JMIR Publications journal.




